New policies at Blue Cross Blue Shield

To ensure and control the proper inventory of paintings located at Blue Cross Blue Shield Tower, the following new guidelines have been implemented:

1. Each artist will sign in the visitor book and be issued a guest pass.
2. If a painting is being brought into the Tower, the painting will be logged in by the security personnel on the current inventory log sheet.
3. If a painting is being removed by the artist, the painting will be logged out of the current inventory sheet by the security officer.
4. If a painting is sold, the artist will notify the security officer of the buyer's identity and the painting sold. The buyer will be directed to the security desk to log the painting out as being sold.
5. Security officers will not accept any usc/payment from any buyers. The artist will set up a mutually agreed date and time with the buyer to accept payment.
