Friday March 7 - **Deliver artwork** to HoFP Gallery, 2828 Devine Street, Columbia, 10:30 - 5:30
Thursday March 13 - **Awards Reception** for artists, patrons & guests, HoFP 5:30 - 7:30
Monday, March 24 - **Pickup artwork** at HoFP, 10:30 - 5:30

Show Rules:

- To enter, one must be a TAG member in good standing (dues paid by December 31, 2007)
- All artwork must be original, completed within the last three years and must not have been entered in any TAG show previously. No nudes will be accepted.
- Members may enter **one** piece of art in any media.
- There is a \$10.00 entry fee.
- Two-dimensional artwork must be framed (wood or metal) or have finished edges (gallery wrap canvas) and must be wired for hanging.
- Please no saw-tooth hangers.
- Size limitations of framed work: Outside measurements must NOT exceed **72 inches for two sides** (height plus width). Three-dimensional work should have its own base.
- All work will be offered for sale unless marked NFS (not for sale).
- HoFP Gallery will handle all sales.
- Artwork must remain on display at HoFP for the entire length of the show (until March 24, 2008).
- HoFP will charge approximately 3% if a piece is purchased with credit; otherwise, they will charge no commission.
- **TAG receives a 10% commission on any work sold.**
- HoFP and TAG are not responsible for loss or damage.
