send is lost and you receive no money from the bogus cashier's check.

A rule of thumb is probably, "when someone asks you to send money anywhere for something you don't have in hand...

READ NOW! 

DON'T CRY LATER! 

- To enter, one must be a TAG member in good standing (dues paid by December 31, 2008)
- All artwork must be original, completed within the last three years and must not have been entered in any TAG show previously. No nudes will be accepted..
- Members may enter one piece of art in any media.
- There is a \$10.00 entry fee.
- Two-dimensional artwork must be framed (wood or metal) or have finished edges (gallery wrap canvas) and must be wired for hanging.
- Please no saw-tooth hangers.

- Size limitations of framed work: Outside measurements must NOT exceed 72 inches for two sides (height plus width)
- Three-dimensional work should have its own base.
- All work will be offered for sale unless marked NFS (not for sale).
- HoFP Gallery will handle all sales.
- Artwork must remain on display at HoFP for the entire length of the show (until March 31, 2009).
- HoFP will charge approximately 3% if a piece is purchased with credit; otherwise, they will charge no commission.
- TAG receives a 10% commission on any work sold.
- HoFP and TAG are not responsible for loss or damage.
