Karen Hagan, a long time resident of Charleston, will be our
 first speaker for the 2009-10 season.

Hagan's paintings offer a compelling combination of dramatic
 light and rugged beauty. Favorite subjects include pristine
 coastal landscapes, boats drenched in sunlight, soulful dancers
 and classical nudes. Her painterly style has developed over the
 last decade, steeped in tradition but unique and completely her
 own. Karen continues her training, drawing the figure in

charcoal in the classical traditional method from life size
 plaster casts and drawing and painting nude figures and
 costumed dancers from live models and from backstage photo
 sessions during live performances as well as painting out of
 doors, en plein air. Hagan's paintings hang in numerous
 private, corporate and yacht collections in the US and abroad.
 Hagan teaches plein air painting in Italy, The Abacos, France
 and in the US.

TAG WORKSHOPS

Oil painting with Kevin LePrince

Kevin LePrince Trenholm Artists Guild Workshops October 16 - 17, 2009, Forest Lake Rec Center

\$300 for 2 day session which includes paints and panels. Students would only need easel, brushes, rags, and container for the spirits.

The workshop will be fun and move fast. It is appropriate for all levels of artists. Students can expect to finish at least two paintings.

Kevin LePrince paints classical subject matter in the "alla prima" style, meaning "at once". His wet on wet method is combined with a traditional impressionistic palette consisting of two blues, two reds and two yellows. His paintings are very recognizable and are full of light, energy, and personality. He is recognized for his ability to recreate a natural scene with his painterly technique. Under the tutelage of renowned artist John Carroll Doyle, LePrince was trained in the classic atelier or studio system. He has studied with master artist David A. Leffel, Kim English and Gregg Kruetz at the Arts Students League of New York and the Fetching Institute in New

Mexico. Although influenced by his instructors, LePrince developed his individual style, which has received much attention from local and national collectors alike. Many of his paintings are followed with clever titles, such as "The Mob Squad," consisting of a cluster of egrets wading together in the water, or "Take Out," an egret entering the shoreline in search of food.

Value/Temperature System Painting with Joyce Hall



January 15 & 16, 2010

\$200 for 2 day sessions which includes a \$50 wooden and glass palette

"The value painting workshop is a system that I have worked out over the years for recognizing the value and temperature of everything that you see and how to paint it. It includes a custom wood enclosed glass palette with removable sliding lid and brass handle.

I require that all my students take this workshop within the first year of their studies. I teach it quarterly in Charleston and have taught it out of town as well. It is always full with a waiting list. Everyone who has taken it has said it changed their lives as painters and taught them to put together everything they had learned but were struggling with.

The course includes a custom made glass and wooden palette that I designed and have made for these workshops (a \$50 value)."

Having left a promising career in equine studies to focus on furthering her artistic abilities, Hall paints exquisitely vivid and profound oil paintings and has been recognized by numerous organizations for her alluring works of art. Joyce is a member of the prestigious Oil Painters of America and the Society of Animal Artists, N.Y. Joyce's work has been recognized around the country with many shows, and she has also been featured in many national magazines, books and posters.

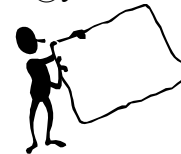
