She offers various courses in painting, drawing, art history and workshops (regional and in Italy). For our meeting, Jean will offer approaches to oil landscape painting using a limited palette, small scale surface and a quick approach. Talk will center on use of complementary colors, finding large shapes and having a great attitude toward the adventure of plein-air painting.

show runs 16 days. May 28th - June 5th, 10-5 daily

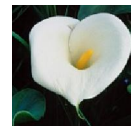

This is a portrait painter's competition in which pairs of artists "face off" against each other and in the first round, the best 8 pictures are selected to "Face Off" in the second round. Rounds two through four eliminate one artist in each pair until, at the end of round four, a winner is determined. The winner will receive a \$500.00 cash prize.

***** Drawing & Design Workshop**

I am pleased to announce the newest art workshop sessions for April 10th, April 24th and May 8th:

In this new Drawing and Design workshop, you will learn the basic principles and elements of design and will learn how to implement this into various drawing and mixed media techniques.

This workshop is designed to encourage artistic creativity through experimentation with art materials. Students are encouraged to follow their instincts and loosen their more emotional/expressive side. Projects will have some guidelines but will not be too restrictive, allowing each person to create something that has a special meaning or quality achieved through an open teaching environment.

The goals of the workshops are to learn how to use the elements and principles of design through drawing and other mixed media techniques.

There are also prizes for second place and the two third place winners. There is a \$30.00 entry fee and a limit to the number of participants. Each round is 90 minutes in length and contestants may use whatever media they wish. TAG members have already produced two winners of the grand prize and we would love to see another TAG member win the big cheese.

First, you will be given an introductory lecture and handouts on the elements and principles of design. Some basic drawing skills will also be demonstrated. Then, you will learn how to handle various drawing and/or painting materials on paper.

We will take a one-hour lunch break from 12:30-1:30. Workshops will be every other weekend, starting with April 10th (#1), April 24th (#2), and May 8th (#3).
