The Deadline to respond is on or before the date of our next meeting, Feb 8. Three members will be selected by the TAG board and notified after the board meeting on Feb 10.

This event will be attended by corporate sponsors, community leaders and arts supporters in our community. Last year's event attendance was 300+ during the three hour event.

Artists will be promoted in all marketing materials promoting the event including print, TV, digital outdoor and social media.

This is a portrait painter's competition in which pairs of artists "face off" against each other and in the first round, the best 8 pictures are selected to "Face Off" in the second round.

Rounds two through four eliminate one artist in each pain until, at the end of round four, a winner is determined. The winner will receive a \$500.00 cash prize.

There are also prizes for second place and the two third place winners. There is a \$30.00 entry fee and a limit to the number of participants. Each round is 90 minutes in length and contestants may use whatever media they wish. TAG members have already produced two winners of the grand prize and we would love to see another TAG member win the big cheese.

- Entry Fee: \$10.00 (To be paid when artwork is delivered on February 26th)
- Members in good standing (dues paid by December 31, 2009) may enter one piece of art in any media.
- All artwork must be original.
- All artwork must have been completed within the last three years and must not have been entered in any TAG show previously.
- No nudes will be accepted.
- Two-dimensional artwork must be framed (wood or metal) or have finished edges (gallery wrap canvas) and must be wired for hanging.
- No saw-tooth hangers.
- Size limitations of framed work: Outside measurements must NOT exceed 72 inches for two sides (height plus width)
- Three-dimensional work should have its own base.
- All work will be offered for sale unless marked NFS (not for sale).
- HoFP Gallery will handle all sales.
- Artwork must remain on display at HoFP for the entire length of the show (until March 31, 2009).
- HoFP will charge approximately 3% for credit card sales. HoFP will not charge a commission.
- TAG receives a 10% commission on any work sold.
- HoFP and TAG are not responsible for loss or damage.
