Coming Events:

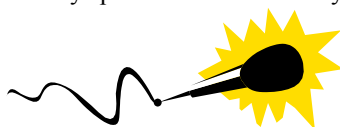

See you on Monday, March 8 for another great meeting and program.

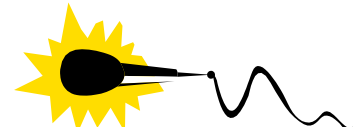

Speaker of the Month Charlynn J M Knight

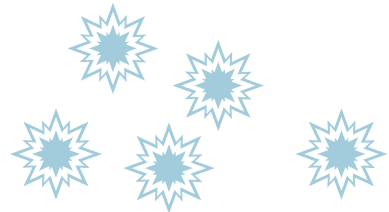
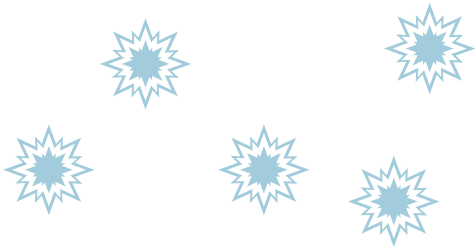
