***ART IN THE PARK – JUNE 5 – QUININE HILL PARK

Come celebrate Spring at an exciting outdoor art event sponsored by the Cultural Council of Richland and Lexington Counties. Art venue arrangements are being handled by the Trenholm Artists Guild.

Who: Artists who wish to demo, sell and/or display their art
When: June 5, 2010 from 10 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.
Where: Quinine Hill Park (corner of Beltline & Forest Drive behind Walgreen's)
Publicity: State Newspaper, WIS-TV, and 40,000 flyers in ValPak mailing.

Registration Deadline: 5 p.m., May 15. Send email to Trenholm_Artists_Guild@yahoo.com. Include name or names of people registering for one space.

There will be space for 25 artists at this event and space will be allotted on a first come, first serve basis. The area is a mostly shaded, fenced park with benches and swings.

Setup for the event will be from 8:30-9:30 a.m. as cars must be moved to the parking area at the Kroger across the street by 9:30 a.m. There will be no charge for a 10' - 12' space,

TAG will charge a 10% commission for all sales. The Trenholm Artists Guild is organizing the art sale but the event is open to other local artists. Non-TAG participants will be required to join TAG (\$20 fee).

Participating artists must provide their own chairs, tables, display stands or tents as needed. Artists are responsible for collecting and paying appropriate sales taxes.

Last year's artists will have first refusal.

We will meet at Capital Bus Tours at 2926 Leaphart Road, West Columbia at 8:30 a.m. They have a large parking area for our cars. We will arrive at the Charleston Visitors Center on Meeting Street around 11:00. The Visitors Center has a juried Spoleto exhibit to view and excellent bathrooms!

We will walk 2 blocks to Marion Square Park where the Piccolo Spoleto artists are set up. This show is free. Across Meeting Street in the courtyard of Second Presbyterian Church, there is the Piccolo Spoleto Fine Crafts Show. Admission to this is \$3, free for seniors. Both of these are wonderful shows!!

Both shows are outside, so dress accordingly. We will go rain or shine.

St. Matthews Lutheran Church (across King Street from Marion Square) also operates a tea room featuring light lunch and desserts.

Lunch options: Second Presbyterian Church operates a tea room during Spoleto from. Between 11:30 and 2:30, they serve Charleston favorites like she-crab soup, okra soup, a variety of salads, etc. Huguenot Torte for dessert! Cost is around \$8.

There are several other restaurants within walking distance from Marion Square: Rue de Jean, Virginia's of King, and numerous restaurants down King Street. Or you can brown bag it in the park!!

*** Gloria Perkins Workshop

My yearly 3 day Workshop that I teach at my home studio in Sharpsburg, Ga. has received such overwhelming response, I will be offering it twice this year. The dates for the Workshop are: July 23-25, 2010 and Sept. 13-15, 2010

I will be teaching. The canvas size of the Gold Leaf painting is 24x36, Roses 20x24, and the wonderful painting I did in Hon Fluer, France last year is 12x16. I think all 3 are real beauties and are filled with learning techniques. These paintings will not be taught at any other venues, so they are specifically designed for this once a year event. The cost for

the 3 day instruction is \$325 which also includes your lunch each day and snacks.

We will have a wine and cheese gathering on the night prior to each session from 6:00-7:00pm. This will allow you to bring in your supplies and see the art hanging in our home. Our location is 20 minutes south of the Atlanta Airport directly off I-85. We have built a state of the art studio which is equipped with artist's lighting and a 50" flat screen TV monitor which is easily visible from any position in the room. A high resolution camcorder with a remote control allow for focusing on the entire canvas or to zoom in on a small area that is being demonstrated. With this arrangement there is no 'bad seat' in the studio.

I have also negotiated a special rate of \$75 at the Sleep Inn in Peachtree City which is wonderful for this area of town. The telephone # is 770-486-0044, and tell reservations the Yvonne gave you the rate of \$69 for the Gloria Perkins Art Workshop. Make your reservation early since they do fill these rooms quickly.
