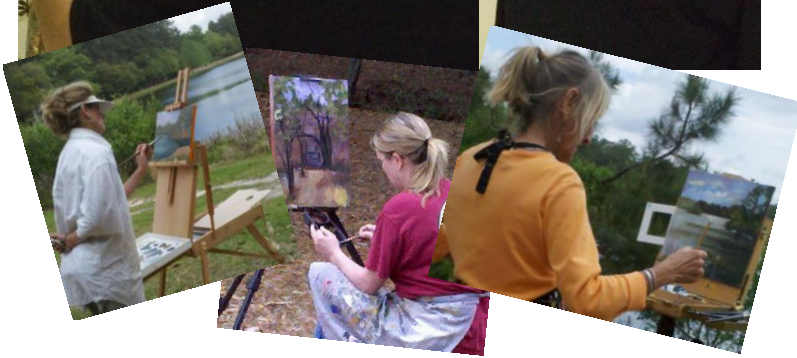
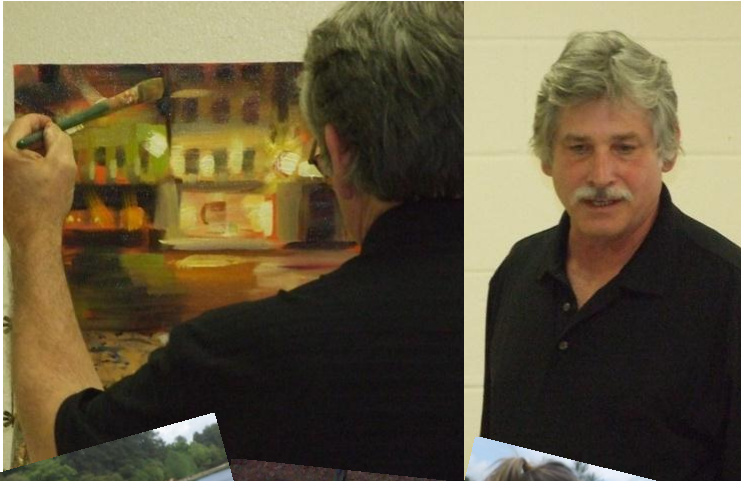

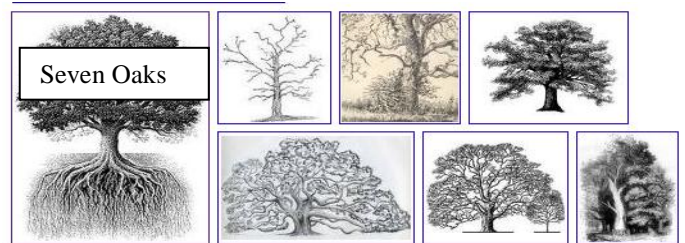

TAG's membership has grown to 160! As the year winds down, we are looking forward to the 2011-12 season. Do you have artist friends who live in the greater

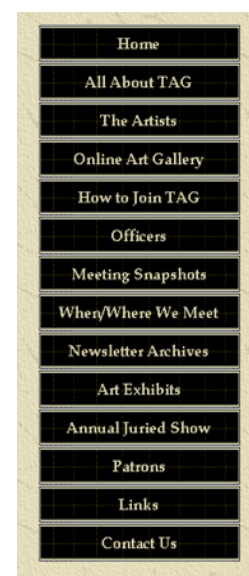
Columbia area who ARE NOT members of TAG? It would be nice to invite them to attend one of our meetings next year. Maybe they would join us too!
