Presentation by Columbia Museum of Art

"*Nature and the Grand American Vision: Masterpieces of the Hudson River School Painters*" is on view through April 1, 2012. The presentation will feature a short, dynamic slide presentation (20 min) highlighting the images in the show and providing information on the painters, their vision and the historical significance of the works.

The forty-five magnificent paintings from the rich collection of the New-York Historical Society are on view at the Columbia Museum of Art in this major traveling exhibition. These iconic works of 19th-century landscape painting are traveling on a national tour for the first time and are circulating to four museums around the country as part of the Historical Society's traveling exhibitions program Sharing a National Treasure. The Columbia Museum of Art is the only stop in the Southeast.

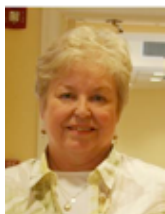

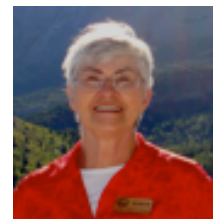

The 501c3 application (\$400 fee) is important to those who donate funds to TAG so that they can claim the deduction on their taxes. We had received a letter from the IRS in 2007 indicating that we had this status, but in 2011, the IRS advised us that the letter was in error and that we would need to apply. Renea Eshleman did the majority of the work for this complicated task.

Bill Arnott found a microphone system that was first used in January at a cost of \$129.69.

TAG's Ongoing Exhibits

TAG invites its members to exhibit their work at any of several rotating exhibit spaces maintained by the guild. Participants must be members of TAG. A facilitator for each exhibit sets dates and times for delivery/pick-up. The facilitator oversees hanging. Pieces must be suitably framed for hanging. Size and number of pieces is at the discretion of the facilitator. TAG display cards must be affixed (available from facilitator). Sales (and collection/payment of sales tax) are between artist and buyer; artists pay 10% to TAG. Specific questions should be directed to the exhibit's facilitator.

Pickup Artwork

- Entry Fee: \$10.00 (To be paid when artwork is delivered on April 6, cash or check payable to TAG)
- Members in good standing (dues paid by December 31, 2011) may enter one piece of art in any media.
- All artwork must be original.
- All artwork must have been completed within the last three years and must not have been entered in any TAG show previously.
- Nudes will be accepted, subject to approval by the president of TAG, show chair, and the owner of HoFP.
- Two-dimensional artwork must be framed (wood or metal) or have finished edges (gallery wrap canvas) and must be wired for hanging; saw-tooth hangers are not acceptable.
- Size limitations of framed work: Outside measurements must NOT exceed 72 inches for two sides (height plus width)
- Three-dimensional work must have its own base.
- Pieces not for sale must be marked NFS (not for sale).
- HoFP Gallery will handle all sales.
- Artwork must remain on display at HoFP for the entire length of the show.
- HoFP will charge approximately 3% for credit card sales. HoFP will not charge a commission.
- TAG receives a 10% commission on any work sold. HoFP and TAG are not responsible for loss or damage. Submission of your work is your acknowledgement that the work represented is original and hand-crafted; that you hold harmless TAG, HOFP, sponsoring and participating organizations, their directors, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any responsibility, personal liability, claims, loss or damage arising out of or in conjunction with your participation.
